

## QHP and MAGI Medi-Cal Enrollees transitioning to Medicare

What individual has	Medicare eligibility	Options*
QHP	Entitled to Part A premium-free	Enroll in Medicare
	Must pay Part A premium	Keep QHP or enroll in Medicare
QHP + premium assistance/cost-sharing subsidy	Entitled to Part A premium-free	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enroll in Medicare</li> <li>• Premium assistance/cost-sharing subsidy ends</li> </ul>
	Must pay Part A premium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keep QHP or enroll in Medicare</li> <li>• If enroll in Medicare, premium assistance/cost-sharing subsidy ends</li> </ul>
MAGI Medi-Cal	Entitled to Part A premium-free Or Must pay Part A premium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enroll in Medicare</li> <li>• MAGI Medi-Cal ends, screened for non-MAGI Medi-Cal, MSP</li> <li>• If eligible for non-MAGI Medi-Cal or MSP, automatically eligible for LIS</li> <li>• If not eligible for non-MAGI Medi-Cal or MSP, apply for LIS</li> </ul>

\*In some situations, if individual is eligible for Medicare but delays enrollment, late enrollment penalty may be imposed when individual enrolls later. For individuals who enroll in Medicare during the General Enrollment Period (Jan - Mar), Medicare benefits are effective Jul 1.
