1	if you are in a medicare advantage plan. if you need to go into hospital for say broken leg-not part of terminal illness-how is this covered?	If a hospice PT seeks treatment that unrelated to terminal diagnosis-prognosis as determined by attending or hospice physician that would be paid for under medicare benefit. This is always evaluated case by case.
2	If a person is receiving IHSS services, would the hospice aid/homemaker still be appropriate/covered? (entered in the chat as well).	Yes, they can receive both. The hospice social worker needs to coordinate this with IHSS
3	(We did have long-term care insurance but it expires in 1 month).	I do not understand the question.
4	What if that person has been on full disability for over 30 years and has no assets and no family members to help?	I do not understand the question.
